Households are an exciting and **POWERFUL** part of our ministry in SPO and especially here at Ohio State. This year we have **21 men** and **17 women** living in household. This means a total of 38 young people living a truly Christian life.

What does it look like to live with Christ as the center of my life and to love others? It is through households that the **art of living** is learned.

Our students commit to 2-3 weekly dinners and 4 days of Morning Prayer each week, chores, our formation program, and being present with each other and the larger community. It is through these commitments and relationships built that these young people are formed in Christian charity and filled with joy.


I am excited to continue my journey to Jesus with these awesome sisters, and I thank God for the ways He has been working in my life through SPO Household!

This year at OSU, in addition to 1 men's house and 2 women's houses on North Campus, we have **2 new Households** on South Campus: the Antioch Men's Outpost and our Women's apartment, Judah.

We are now in close proximity to the Student Union, 20 Residence Halls, Greek housing and the social hub of campus. There are **abundant opportunities** to be an even greater and more consistent presence in the lives of many students.
